A. Preface

Skill Explained:

A hairdresser generally works in the commercial sector, offering a range of services and treatments to the hair for individual clients. Hairdressing is closely associated with other parts of the service sector, and with the many products that support it, normally for commercial purposes.

Hairdressing also has an important therapeutic role in supporting individuals' self-esteem and confidence. It also helps to relieve the effects of illness, and can aid recovery.

He or she may offer a wide range of services, including cutting, colouring, styling, chemical reformation, and special hair treatments. Whatever the structure of the work, the trained and experienced hairdresser takes on a high level of personal responsibility and autonomy, from safe working, to achieving exceptional effects for special occasions.

For the talented hairdresser there are many commercial and international opportunities; however, these carry with them the need to understand and work with diverse cultures, trends, and hair types.

MODULE A – LADIES FASHION LONG HAIR DESIGN WITH 3 WISHES

MANNEQUIN

TIME: 2 hours 30 minutes

Description

The finished result should be a long hair down design with commercial colouring, based on the three wishes. The finished look should be corresponding to the brief for the module. This module should not be styled like OMC hairstyles. This module must respect industry standards.

Three Wishes

The wishes will be decided by the Judges and Beauty & Wellness representative. Three wishes will be released just before competition starts with the pictures. Competitors must pick up main elements from the three wishes & create the hairstyle.

Client wishes will consist of these inspiration wishes:

- Texture
- Form
- Colour

Colour

- Commercial colouring as requested.
- All of the hair must be coloured.
- All colouring techniques and colours are allowed.
- Must respect client's inspiration wishes – picture.

Finished Result

- All combs and brushes are allowed.
- No external fillers of any materials are allowed.
- No ornaments in this module.
- Bobby pins, pins, rubber bands are allowed while styling but not to be left on the finished style.
- All styling products are allowed.
- Finished result does not have to replicate of inspiration pictures, but inspiration wishes must be main elements in finished result.

MODULE B – LADIES LONG HAIR BRIDAL HAIRDO

MANNEQUIN: Same mannequin as in module A

TIME: 1 hour 30 mins

Description

The Competitor can design the bridal hairdo.

The designs must be performed according to the fashion trends in the bridal industry. The look should be commercial and not styled like an OMC Bridal hairstyle.

The Competitor must create a hairstyle that will complement the ornament used. The hair ornaments should not cover the entire/half of the head.

Finished Style

- Free choice of tools allowed.
- Competitors can use only one piece as ornament.
- Hairnets are not allowed.
- Stuffing is not allowed.

- No colouring in this test.
- No cutting in this test.
- All styling products are allowed what are supplied from sponsor.

MODULE C – LADIES FASHION HAIRCUT & COLOR WITH 3 WISHES

MANNEQUIN: SAME AS MODULE A & B

TIME: 2 hours 30 minutes

Description

Competitor will get 3 wishes and she/he will create wearable fashion hairstyle what is suitable for that picture.

The finished look should reflect the fashion trends in women's haircuts and colouring. The look should be fashion and not be performed in the style of OMC. The finished result should look like a picture from fashion magazine.

Three Wishes

The wishes will be decided by the Judges at the start of the competition. Inspiration wishes needs to be main elements in finished result.

Client wishes will consist of:

- Cut= inspiration wishes (pick up main points).
- Colour = inspiration wishes (pick up main points).
- Texture= inspiration wishes (pick up main points).

Haircut

- All hairdressing tools are allowed.
- Must respect client inspiration wishes

Colour

- All hair must be coloured.
- Must be wearable fashion colour.
- Must respect client inspiration wishes.
- The colouring should correspond to the fashion trends, and not be avant-garde.

Finished Style

- All tools are allowed.
- Must respect client wishes.
- Three wishes need to be main elements in finished result.
- All styling products are allowed.
- The hair can cover the eye, if it is necessary for the fashion picture.

MODULE D – MEN’S FASHION HAIR CUT & COLOR FROM PHOTO

MANNEQUIN

TIME: 2 hours 30 minutes

Description

This will be men’s fashion haircut and colour worn by everyday men’s. Competitor are required to reproduce the photography (very similar to the haircut and blowdry).

Haircut

- The look is fashion inspired.
- All Cutting techniques and tools are allowed.
- Clippers with guards may be used.
- Haircut replicated as close as possible from the picture.
- The hair at the back & sides cannot be cut very short, minimum length should be 1.5 inches from the scalp at the back & 1 inches on the sides.
- All hair must be cut not trimmed.

Colour

- Must be fashion colour not Avant Garde. The competitor has a free choice in choosing a colour, minimum 2 colours including base colour.
- All colouring techniques are allowed.
- All colour products are allowed.
- All the hair must be coloured.
- There will be one inspiration wishes from the client (pick up main points).

Finished Style

- All tools are allowed
- All styling products are allowed.
- Blow dry replicated as close as possible from the picture.

MODULE E – MEN’S TRADITIONAL TAPER CUT & BLOW DRY

MANNEQUIN: SAME USED IN MODULE D

TIME: 45 minutes

Description

This module calls for Men’s traditional haircut and blow-dry. Necklines and sides are traditionally tapered and graduated. It is necessary to use techniques and skills of precision cutting. Haircut must reflect a commercial hair design, worn by the everyday Men’s. The finished look should not reflect the classic men’s haircuts in the style of OMC.

Haircut

- The neckline is tapered to zero just above the collar line. The first line of hair at the nape and sides must be 0.
- All tools are allowed except no clippers.

Colour

- No any colour in this test.

Finished Style

- All styling tools are allowed to create male hairstyle.
- Finished style must not be like OMC Men's classical.
- The use of the "pan" is not allowed.
- Brushes and/or combs are allowed.
- All styling products are allowed.

C. Marking Scheme

The Assessment is done by awarding points by adopting two methods, Measurement and Judgments

Aspects are criteria which are judged for assessment

Measurement is used to assess accuracy, precision, and other performance which can be measured in unambiguous way. Mark is awarded in full for a dimension within tolerance and zero when it is out of tolerance.

Judgment is used to assess the quality of performance, about which there may be small differences of opinion.

The scores from 0 to 3 are awarded for conformity with industry standards (score 1 stands for 1/3 and score 2 for 2/3 of the maximum mark allotted for the criterion).

Example-Judgment Marking

If maximum marks for Judgment criteria are 1 and if all 3 Experts (Juries) give 3 points to a candidate, the candidate will get 1 mark for that aspect. If 2 Experts give 3 and 1 Expert gives 2 points, then candidate will get $(3+3+2)/9 \times 1 = 0.89$ marks for that aspect out of 1 mark.

Section – E

E. Instructions for candidates

1. All accredited participants and supporting volunteers will abide by rules and regulations with regards to Health, Safety, and Environment of the Competition venue.
2. All participants, technicians and supporting staff will wear the required protective Personnel clothing such as closed shoes, apron, gloves and mask during color service.
3. All participants will assume liability for all risks of injury and damage to property, loss of property, which might be associated with or result from participation in the event. The organizers will not be liable for any damage, however in case of Injury the competitor will immediately inform the immediate organizer for medical attention.
4. Competitor will wear the specified clothes by Beauty and Wellness Sector Skill Council.
5. The model needs to wear just a single black outfit. The judges will judge the haircut/hairstyle not the Outfit or jewellery worn by the models.
6. Competitor cannot have any logos of Brands/Organizations or Associations on their kits etc.
7. Competitors will only use the Cape/Apron provided by the Beauty and Wellness Sector Skill Council.
8. Competitors, Judges, Support Team are not allowed to use any personal photo or video taking devices On the competition floor once the competition is underway.
9. If a piece of equipment fails, the time keeper notes the time and this time will be added at the end of That module time.

Section – F

F. Health, Safety, and Environment

- Competitor and model needs to wear closed comfortable shoes. No high heels.
- As soon as the competition starts work with electric equipment's they need they need to keep the manufacturer's instruction in mind.
- If a competitor injures themselves and unable to continue until the required first aid has been given. No additional time is to be added to their competition time.
- No item can be used that will penetrate the client's skin.
