In order to comply with the quality improvement directives given by the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Hon ble Minister, Labour Resources, Government of Bihar, a revised pattern of Kushal Yuva Program (KYP) is being launched wef. November 2022 KYP Batch. This new pattern has been designed for further quality improvement of KYP and shall be referred to as **KYP 22 Pattern**.

The details about the KYP 2022 Pattern are given in Annexure-I enclosed herewith.

The KYP 22 Pattern shall be explained in detail in a Consultative Meeting of KYP-SDC Coordinators at each district headquarter. You are requested to depute all the Registered Center Coordinator of your SDC to attend the Orientation Meeting without fail.

In this meeting, explanations will be offered to the clarifications, concerns or difficulties, if any, sought, expressed or asked by the KYP-SDC Coordinators so as to finalize the details of KYP 22 Pattern with their participation.

This meeting shall be conducted on a working day tentatively <u>between October 7 and 15, 2022</u>. The, Date, Timings and Venue of this meeting shall be communicated to you soon by email. Attendance of KYP-SDC Coordinators is mandatory and it will be recorded at the start and end of the meeting.

Annexure I KYP 22 Pattern

- A. Name of the Program: Kushal Yuva Program (KYP)
- B. Name of the Pattern: KYP 22
- C. Proposed Date of Commencement: November 01, 2022.
- D. Effect on Ongoing Batches: Learners undergoing KYP in ongoing Batches as well as in those who will be admitted to October 2022 Batch shall continue and complete their learning as per the current pattern. The learners registering for November 2022 Batch onwards shall be admitted to KYP 22 Pattern.
- E. Components of KYP: KYP 22 consists of following 3 courses:
 - 1. Bihar State Certificate in Information Technology (BS-CIT)
 - 2. Bihar State Certificate in Language Skills (BS-CLS English)
 - 3. Bihar State Certificate in Soft Skills (BS-CSS)
- F. Total Number of Hours of KYP: 240 Hours

BS-CIT – 120 Hours; BS-CLS - English – 80 Hours; BS-CSS – 40 Hours Each of the 2 Hours are grouped in a Session. As such, BS-CIT will consist of 60 Sessions; BS-CLS -English will consist of 40 Sessions and BS-CSS will consist of 20 Sessions.

G. Mode of Learning:

- 1. Fully Lab-Based eLearning (No Classroom-Based Learning)
- 2. Center-Based Quasi-Online eLearning
- 3. One computer to be exclusively allotted to only one Learner throughout the Session of 2
- 4. Self-Learning, Self-Paced Learning, Strictly Sequential Learning and Verifiable Evidence-Based Assessment (by using physical and virtual cameras and MKCL's Black Box Technology) in MKCL's eLearning Management System (ERA) 5. Learning Facilitator-Assisted eLearning
- Learning with collaboration among the Learners who are physically present in the KYP-6. SDC Lab and have logged on to ERA. 7. During a Session, a few minutes of Inform Content will be followed by few minutes of
- Perform Content / Hand-on Practice followed by a few minutes of Continuous Comprehensive Assessment (CCA). There will be many sets of these inform-performassessment in a given session of 2 Hours. Learner has to complete all sets in a Session.
- 8. Maximum Marks for assessment in each session will be 10.
- 9. Total marks scored in CCA in each course shall be given 50% weightage and remaining 50% weightage shall be given to marks scored in Final Online Examination of that course.
- H. Permitted Hours of Learning Per Day: Up To 04 Hours (i.e. not more than 04 Hours per day) Learner may learn for either 2 Hours or 4 Hours per working day.

This 2 Hours / Day facility is being additionally introduced to offer flexibility for facilitating the students attending school / junior college / ITI / Polytechnic / Senior College, etc. and desirous of parallelly completing KYP.

- Normal Working Hours of KYP-SDC: 07.00 am to 07.00 pm on all working days. 1. i.e. Each computer in the KYP-SDC can be used by maximum of six Learners each for two hours or maximum of three Learners each for 4 hours. All other permissible combinations of number of Learners opting for either 2 Hours or 4 Hours slots shall be allowed.
- J. Duration for KYP Completion:
 - 1. 240 Hours of learning can be completed in maximum 3 months, if a Learner is attending
 - 2. 240 Hours of learning can be completed in maximum 6 months, if a Learner is attending
 - 3. 240 Hours of learning can be completed in maximum more than 3 and less than 6 months, if a Learner is attending for 2 Hours / Day on some days and 4 Hours / Day on other days and not attending on a few days due to school / college exams, etc.
- K. Learning Sequence: First 40 Sessions (each of 2 Hours) of BS-CIT and all 40 Sessions of BS-CLS -English will be learnt alternately and remaining 20 Sessions of BS-CIT and all 20 Sessions of BS-CSS will be learnt alternately so as to ensure that both the BS-CIT and (BS-CLS + BS-CSS) courses are learnt parallelly and completed together.
- Continuous Comprehensive Assessment: During the learning process in a session, the eLearning Management System-ERA shall documentable learning evidence in the form of snaps from the L. physical and virtual camera and shall upload them to Central Server based on consistent bandwidth available in the KYP-SDC.
- M. Eligibility for Final Online Examination: In order to become eligible for Final Online Examination, each Learner has to complete all the 60 Sessions of BS-CIT, 40 Sessions of BS-CLS - English and 20 Sessions of BS-CSS. Unless and until the Learner acquires the skill by solving all the assignments independently s/he shall not be allowed to access the next sequential session.
- N. Final Online Examination and Certification: The norms for Final Online Examination and Certification including those for passing criteria and re-examination attempts shall remain unchanged under KYP 22.
- O. Invoices and Payment: The norms for invoices and payment as well as those for refund of the deposit to the Learners shall remain unchanged under KYP 22.
