In line of India Skill Competition-2025, a total of **4,481 candidates has registered on** Skill India Digital Hub (SIDH) **under 57 skills adopted by BSDM**. The competition structure includes multiple stages: District/Zonal, State, and regional levels, leading up to the National and International competition.

In the previous edition, the NSDC had shortlisted candidates from the registered pool and shared the list with Bihar Skill Development Mission (BSDM) for conducting the District-level competitions.

For the current cycle, the complete details of **4,481** registered candidates has been shared with BSDM. BSDM will now undertake the **Screening Process** and initiate the District/Zonal-level competitions, which will subsequently be followed by the State-level competitions as per the defined MSDE guidelines and timelines.
