

In line of India Skill Competition-2025, a total of **4,481 candidates** has registered on Skill India Digital Hub (SIDH) **under 57 skills adopted by BSDM**. The competition structure includes multiple stages: District/Zonal, State, and regional levels, leading up to the National and International competition.

In the previous edition, the NSDC had shortlisted candidates from the registered pool and shared the list with Bihar Skill Development Mission (BSDM) for conducting the District-level competitions.

For the current cycle, the complete details of **4,481** registered candidates has been shared with BSDM. BSDM will now undertake the **Screening Process** and initiate the District/Zonal-level competitions, which will subsequently be followed by the State-level competitions as per the defined MSDE guidelines and timelines.

The Competition level, Selection process & Competition Format may include the following:

Competition Level	Selection Process	Competition Format
Qualifying Level/Screening	The candidates who will appear in the screening test, must secure a minimum of 50% marks or above shall be eligible for the district-level competition.	Test will be conducted on virtual mode. Multiple choice questions Maximum Time: 1 hour Maximum Marks: 100
District/Zonal Level	Candidates shall appear physically for the district/Zonal level Skill competition. Those candidates who will secure 60% marks or above shall be eligible for the state-level competition. The district/zonal level competition shall be organised for the job roles/ Skills if the number of participants is more than 10; less than 10 participants in any skills shall be directly enter into the state level competition.	The District Skill Competition shall be organised at the BSDM partnered agency locations only. The tests can be one of the following modes: Demonstration of Skills or/and Test Projects or/and Question & Answers or/and Personal interview. Maximum Time: 2 to 5 Hours, depend on the job role/skills type. Maximum Marks: 100 Marks
State Level	Candidates shall appear physically for the state skill competition. The top 3 candidates shall be selected from the total number of eligible candidates at the state skill competition. Candidates must secure 70% or more to qualify for the Regional Competition. Selection of candidates/teams under the top 3 categories does not reserve the right to nominate candidates to enter the Regional Competition. The finalist participation at the regional competition shall be decided amongst the top 3 winners at State skill competition. The nomination shall be done basis on the performance at the state skills marks & training assessment report submitted by the training agency before the Regional Competition.	The State Skill Competition shall be organised at the BSDM partnered agency locations. Demonstration of Skills and Test Projects and Personal interview. Maximum Time: 5 to 8 hours, depend on the job roles/ skills type. Maximum Marks: 100 Marks

This approach ensures a structured and credible progression of candidates through the various stages, ultimately identifying the most skilled individuals to represent at the National and International Level from Bihar.
